

ORDINANCE NO. 12

Peddler's License

It shall be unlawful for any person not a resident of the Town of Vernon to offer for sale or sell within the corporate limits of the Town any goods, wares or merchandise without having first filed a written application for and obtained a peddler's license.

The application for a peddler's license shall be in writing and shall be signed by the applicant and shall be subscribed and sworn to before a notary public or other person authorized to administer oaths. The application shall state the name, age, residence of the applicant, the name of the company, person, firm or corporation for which he works, a list of all products which he will offer for sale, and a statement of whether the applicant has been convicted of any crime.

The issuance of any peddler's license shall be discretionary with the Mayor and the Mayor shall impose a license fee of \$5.00 per day for each day such license shall continue in effect.

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall on conviction thereof be fined in any sum not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 and each day that such violation shall continue shall be considered a separate offense.
