

ORDINANCE NO. 135

Whereas, THE Common Council of the Town of Vernon, Indiana has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town, its citizens and its merchants to promote orderly parking and commerce on the west side of Pike Street from Jackson Street (Highway 3 and 7) to Brown Street in the Town. Various businesses are located on that side of Pike Street.

Accordingly upon motion duly made and seconded, the Council voted unanimously to consider the ordinance on first reading. Further, upon ~~notice~~^{motion (Bick)} duly made and seconded, the Council voted unanimously to enact the following ordinance:

BE IT SO ORDAINED, that effective upon passage of this ordinance, motor vehicles shall be parked for no more than two (2) hours total from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday on the west side of Pike Street from Jackson Street (Highway 3 and 7) to Brown Street in the Town of Vernon, Indiana.

Further, any law enforcement officer, including the Town Marshall of Vernon, Indiana, shall have the authority to enforce this ordinance by having the offending vehicle towed at the owner's expense.

Further, the Town shall post signs "Two Hour Parking" on the west side of Pike Street.


