REGULATING TRAFFIC FLOW ON PIKE STREET AND GAINES STREET


Be it duly enacted by the Common Council of the Town of Vernon on June
1, 2017:


- 1.) It is necessary that the Town of Vernon regulate traffic flow on Pike Street and Gaines Street to promote safety and the orderly flow of traffic.
- 2.) Therefore, be it enacted effective the date of this ordinance that motor vehicles over _____ feet in height shall not be permitted to use and drive on Pike Street in the Town of Vernon between Brown Street and Ripley Street and that appropriate signs be posted.
- 3.) Further, be it enacted effective the date of this ordinance that there shall be no motor vehicle parking on Gaines Street in the Town of Vernon between Pike Street and Montgomery Street.
- 4.) Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Common Council of the Town of Vernon voted unanimously to consider this ordinance on first reading on June 1, 2017.
- 5.) Then, upon motion duly made and seconded, the Common Council of the Town of Vernon voted unanimously to pass this Ordinance.




