

ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE BUILDING OF FIRES ON STREETS.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Vernon, Indiana, that:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or cause to be burned leaves, brush, rubbish or other combustibles upon any street in the Town of Vernon where the street is paved with concrete, brick, asphalt, or other type of paving.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than one nor more than twenty-five dollars for each offense so committed.
