

ORDINANCE NO. 3

Town Boundaries and Wards

The bounds of the corporation Town of Vernon shall extend to a line 132 feet South of and parallel to South Street and to a line 300 feet West <sup>of</sup> and parallel to Water Street, the territory within these bounds shall be divided into three wards by two lines running east and west through the corporation. One of said lines shall be formed by the center line of Jackson Street. The other line shall be formed by the center line of Brown Street. The territory south of the center line of Jackson Street shall constitute the first ward. The territory between the center line of Jackson Street and the center line of Brown Street shall constitute the second ward. The territory between the center line of Brown Street and the north bound of the corporation shall constitute the third ward.
