

ORDINANCE NO. 4

Mayor's Court

Section I. The Mayor of the Town of Vernon shall keep a court docket similar to those kept by Justices of the Peace under the laws of the State of Indiana and shall remit to the State of Indiana such docket fees as the State demands and shall report all traffic offense convictions as required by law.

Section II. In addition to his regular salary the Mayor shall be entitled to the sum of \$3.00 in each criminal case decided in his court and said fee shall be assessed as part of the costs of the trial and shall be paid by the defendant if the defendant is found guilty as charged.
