

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF
VEHICLES ON THE COURTHOUSE SQUARE IN
THE TOWN OF VERNON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VERNON FROM AND
AFTER THE ENACTMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE:

SECTION I:

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the
Town of Vernon on the West side of Pike Street between Brown Street and
State Road 7 & 3 except in a diagonal manner in spaces as indicated by
marked lines painted on the pavement of Pike Street and no vehicle shall remain
parked on this portion of Pike Street between the hours of 7:00 A. M. and
6:00 P. M. for a longer period of time than one hour.

SECTION II:

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the
Town of Vernon on the West side of Perry Street between Brown Street and
State Road 7 & 3 except in a diagonal manner in spaces as indicated by
marked lines painted on the pavement of Perry Street.

SECTION III:

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on the South side
of Brown Street between Pike Street and Perry Street, on the East side of Perry
Street between Brown Street and State Road 7 & 3, on the North side of State
Road 7 & 3 between Perry Street and Pike Street, and on the East side of Pike
Street between Brown Street and State Road 7 & 3 except in a manner parallel
to the edge of the street and in a manner known as flat parking within spaces
designated by painted lines on the street pavement.

SECTION IV:

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty
of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not
less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00 for the first violation and in any sum
not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50.00 for any second or subsequent
conviction.
