

TOWN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE #61

WHEREAS. Certain extraordinary condotions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of Town Government, in order to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION I. Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Vernon, Indiana, that for the expenses of the Town Government and its institutions for the year ending December 31, 1973, the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, and such sums herein appropriated shall include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION II. For said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the Town fund hereinafter named the following specified amounts:

Funds

Road and Street Fund	
Resurfacing of Streets	3241.43
Cumulative Capital Improvement Fund	
Town's 10% Share	324.14

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage.
