ORDINANCE # 74

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING MOTOR VEHICLE HIGHWAY FUNDS TO
THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING TRANSPORTATION
EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE TOWN MARSHAL IN THE PURSUIT OF HIS
DUTIES

WHEREAS, the Marshal of the Town of Vernon is paid a nominal fee for
his services, and

WHEREAS, his duties require him to furnish his own transportation,
and,

WHEREAS, the cost of operating said vehicle is excessive, and

WHEREAS, THE NECESSARY FUNDS ARE NOT AVAILABLE IN THE GENERAL FUND
budget, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interest of
the Town to transfer money from the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund to the
General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

SECTION 1. The Marshal of the Town of Vernon be allowed an additional
sum of _____ per month to help defray the trans-
portation costs of fulfilling his duties to the Town.

SECTION 2. The sum of _____ shall be
transferred from the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund to the General Fund for the
purpose of reimbursing the Marshal, in part, for transportation costs in-
curred in the line of duty.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
after its passage.
