

ORDINANCE NO. 82

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL THE MAXIMUM  
SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN  
THE TOWN OF VERNON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Board of Vernon, Indiana, that it is a threat to the public safety and welfare of the citizens of said Town to allow motor vehicles to operate within the Town limits at speeds in excess of twenty-five miles per hour;

THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF VERNON, INDIANA, THAT:


Section 1. No driver of any motor vehicle shall operate said vehicle on any street located in the Town of Vernon, Indiana, at a speed greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Section 2. Any person convicted of a violation of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be fined in an amount not to exceed Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for each violation.

Section 3. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
