

ORDINANCE - 88

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AN
HISTORIC DISTRICT AND
CLASSIFY THE BUILDINGS
THEREIN FOR THE TOWN
OF VERNON, INDIANA

WHEREAS THE TOWN BOARD OF VERNON, INDIANA has created by ordinance and the Mayor of the Town of Vernon, Indiana has appointed, with the approval of the members of the Council, an HISTORIC BOARD OF REVIEW whose first duty is to establish by Ordinance an HISTORIC DISTRICT and classify the buildings therein as historic or non historic.


THE HISTORIC BOARD OF REVIEW has established the map. The map designates all of the Town of Vernon, Indiana as an HISTORIC DISTRICT. The map also designates all of the buildings therein as historic or nonhistoric. The map has been presented to the Town Board of Vernon, Indiana for review.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF VERNON, INDIANA that the above-referenced map established by the HISTORIC BOARD OF REVIEW is hereby approved. Therefore, the entire Town of Vernon, Indiana is designated as an historic district pursuant to Ind. Code 36-7-11-6 and all of the buildings contained therein are hereby classified as set out on the map.

Pursuant to Ind. Code 36-1-5-4, the map developed by the HISTORIC BOARD OF REVIEW and approved herein and a notebook of block drawings with location index and a card file classifying the buildings are incorporated by reference herein. THE TOWN BOARD OF REVIEW also approves the above notebook and card file. Two (2) copies of the map, notebook, and card file are on file in the office of the clerk of the Town Board of Vernon and are open for public inspection.
